

Puzzle 2: Whoo-Hooo!

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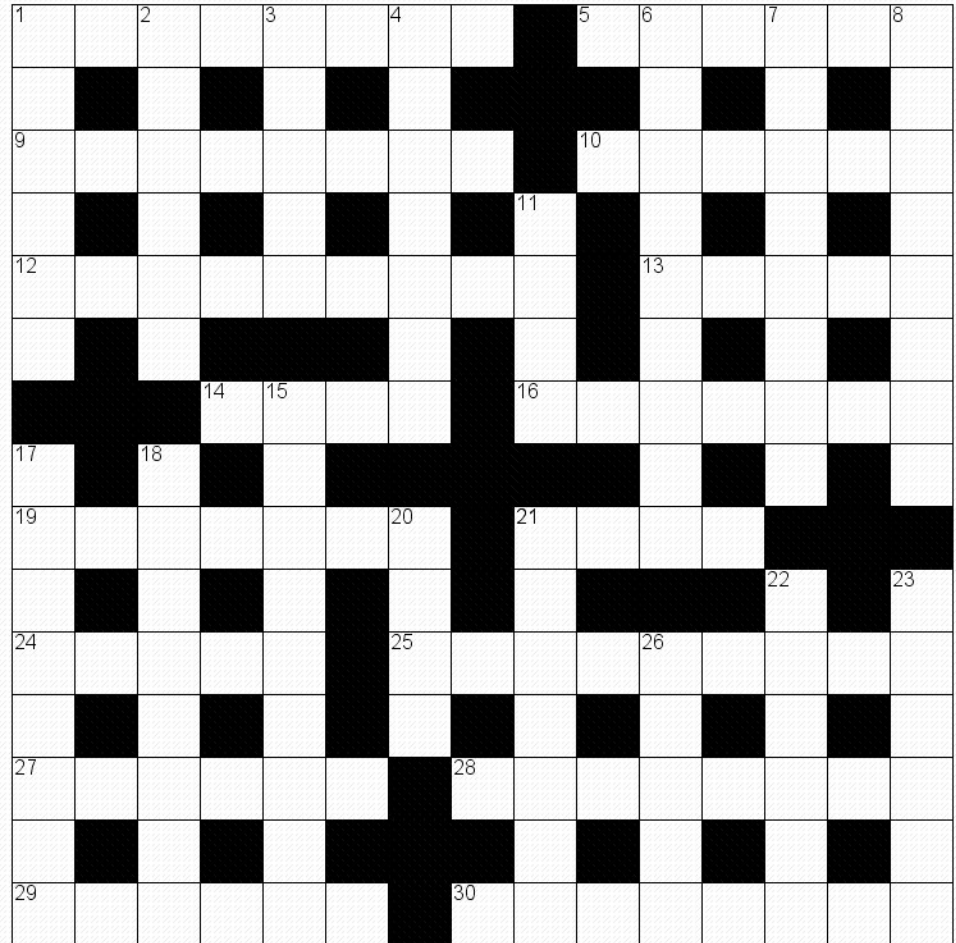
What tune is hinted at by this puzzle?
